IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LEADERSHIP PREP

******Please read this carefully BEFORE you apply******

Leadership Prep is different than other public schools. We are dedicated to preparing every student for COLLEGE. Getting different results like this, means being a different kind of school.

It is important going in that you understand some of the ways Leadership Prep is different and are willing to do the WORK it takes to have your student be successful here.

Ways in which Leadership Prep is different:

LEARNING TIME IS SACRED: students who miss learning time have a hard time keeping up so:

- Our school day goes from 7:15AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Thursday (7:15 AM to 1:30 PM on Friday)
- Tutoring, for students who need it, is from 4:00PM to 5:00PM (*****families of students who need the extra help of tutoring are responsible for arranging for them to be picked up from tutoring*****)
- Doctor's appointments, vacations, etc happen only on Friday afternoons and during school vacations; never during the school day.
- Accumulating 9 absences means that a student may or may not be promoted to the next grade
- 3 tardies (that is arrival after 7:15 AM) = 1 absence

DAILY PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT: students need to practice the skills they are learning in school at home EVERY DAY so:

- We have 20 minutes of homework and 20 minutes of reading at home EVERY night
- Completing homework and reading every night is mandatory

BEST BEHAVOIR: school needs to be an orderly place where students can focus on learning and teachers can focus on teaching so:

- We "sweat the small stuff" (standing up straight, shirt tucked in, etc.) so that the bigger things (pushing, hitting, etc) never happen
- We will ask you to be a partner with us in helping students learn to meet our high standards by reinforcing their importance to your scholar at home

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: communication and partnership between families and schools helps students to excel so:

- We have mandatory, in-person report card conferences 3 times each year
- We are in frequent contact with you via phone and letters and ask that you be in contact with us whenever you have a question or concern
