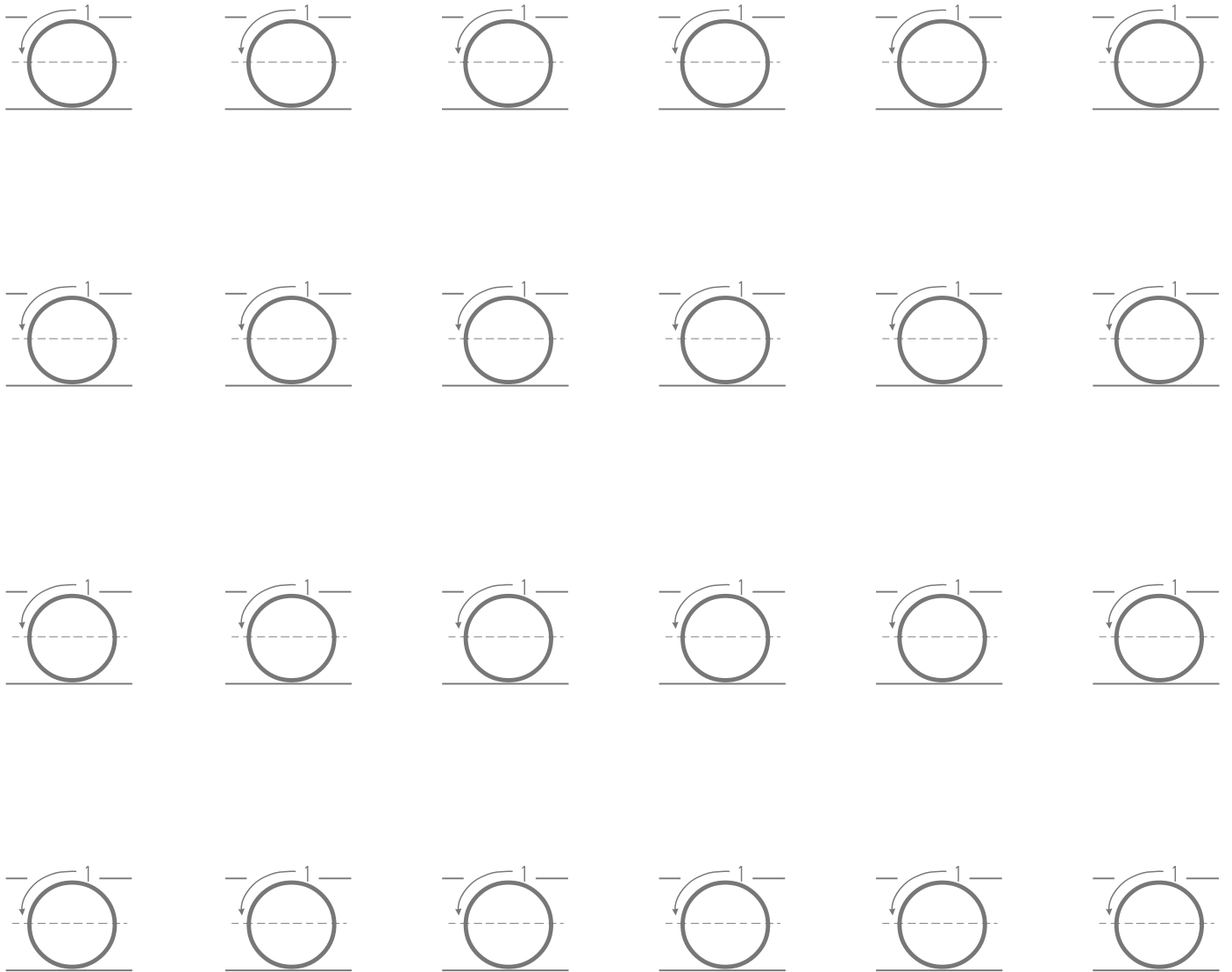
NOTE: If you are not printing this resource, your child can refer to the examples and then practice these same strokes and shapes on any piece of paper.

Backward Circles

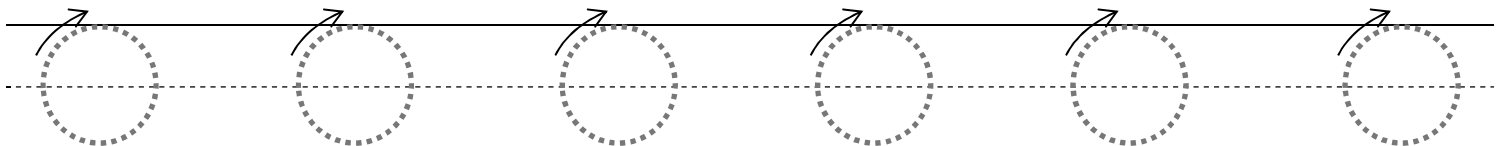
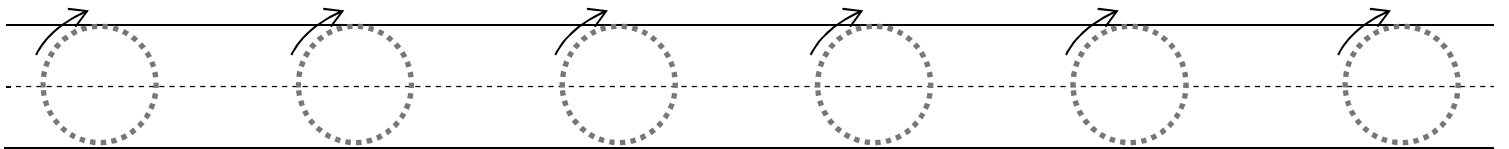
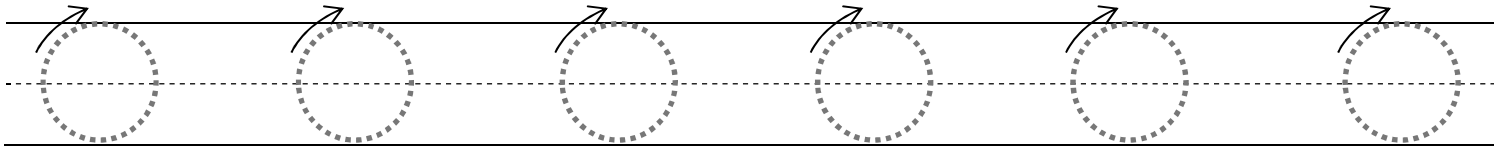
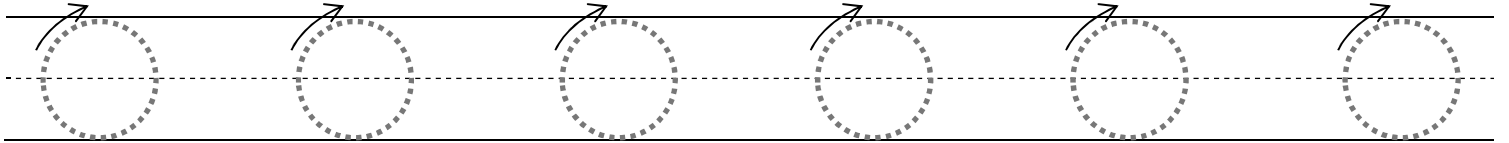
Trace the circles, following the arrow.





Forward Circles

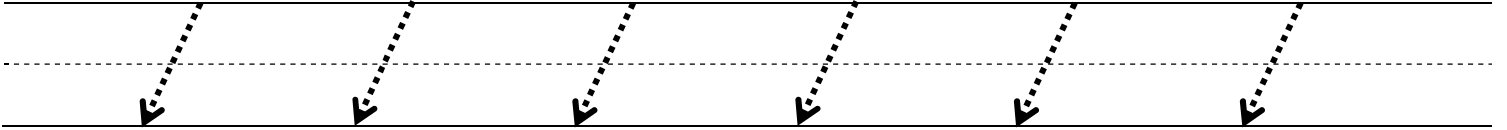
Trace the circles, following the arrow.



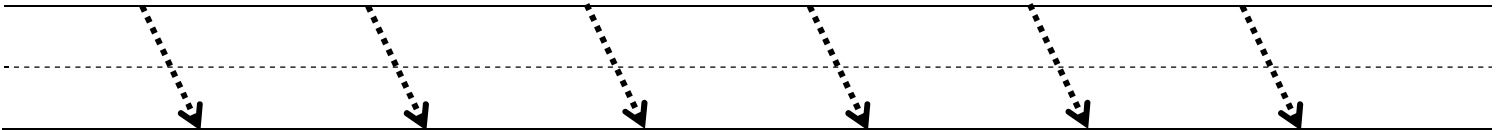


Slant Lines

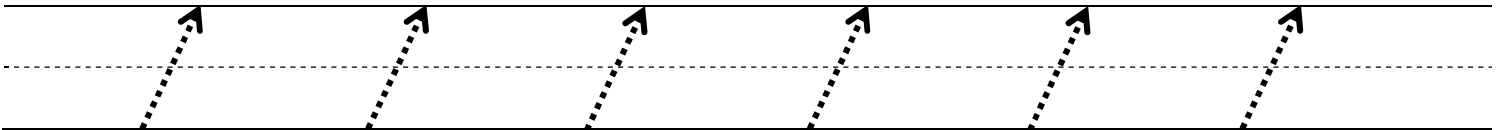
Start at the top, and trace the slanted line down to the left.

Start at the bottom, and trace the slanted line up to the right.



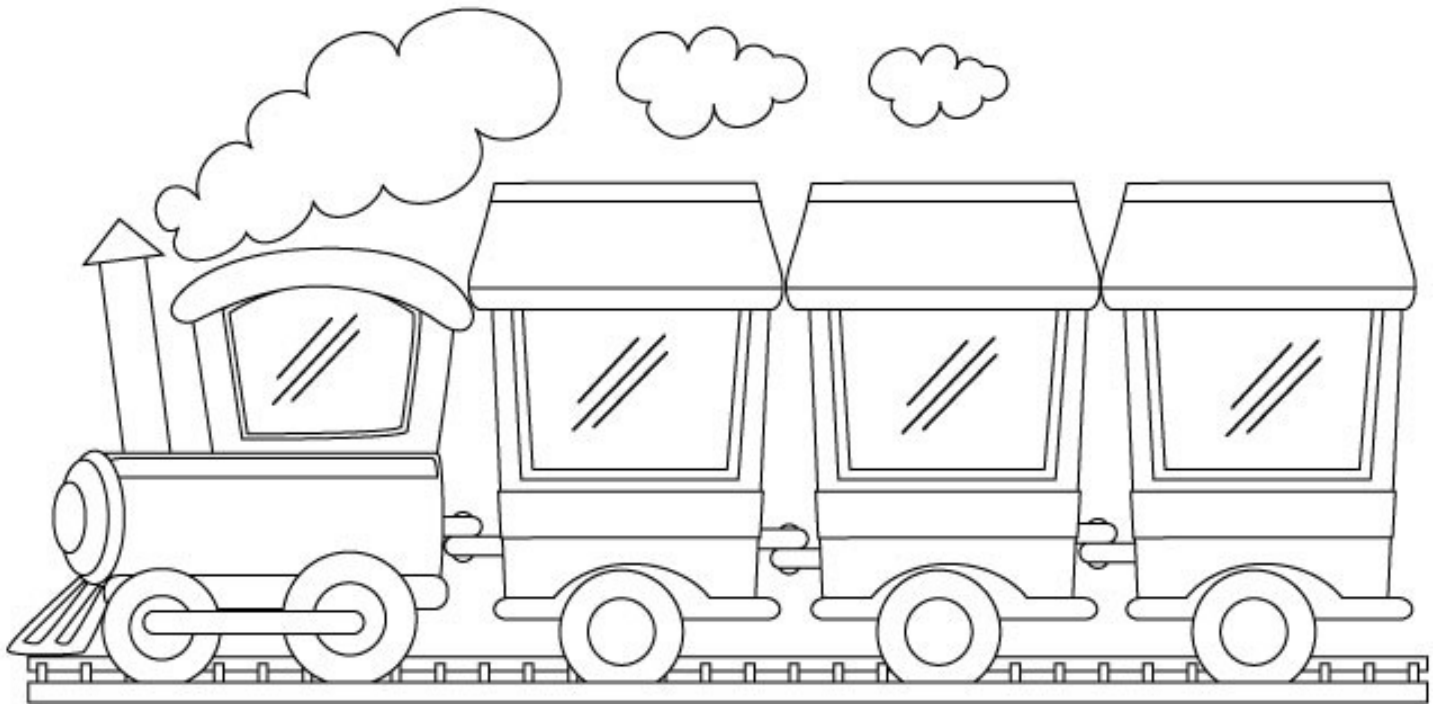
Start at the bottom, and trace the slanted line up and then back down.
