<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: These Dolch Primer Sight Words are among the most commonly used sight words for new readers! Create an index card for each word. Practice reading one word at a time. If there is hesitation or the word is pronounced incorrectly move on and come back to the word. Target just 4-5 words at a time, and continue until all words are mastered. Remember to switch the order of the index cards so that your child does not memorize the order of the words. <u>Do this activity with your child with an encouraging smile</u>. This should be fun and no stress!
